This training programme aims to empower the technicians working in the dental laboratory during pandemic. The outbreak of coronavirus disease (COVID-19) has necessitated the reinforcement of infection control measures in the dental laboratory setting. The precautions are mandatory to cease any transmission of COVID-19 to the patient, dentist, or dental technicians working in labs. Caution should be taken for all steps of dental laboratory processes of prosthesis fabrication viz. pre processing, processing and post processing.

Standard precautions must be followed at all times when laboratory staff handles clinical impressions, tissue samples, or dental appliances which may contain infectious microorganisms. There should be the minimal formation of aerosols ensured while undertaking all technical procedures of processing.

Objectives:

- To empower technicians on infection control in handling dental impressions and prosthesis fabrication during pandemic
- To train technicians on minimizing risk while handling oral tissue samples during pandemic
